Point of Presence Building

These buildings, located at substations across our service area, act as the main switchboards along our network. They house the devices that power our fiber-to-the-home network. The devices inside of this building connect to the larger fiber ring, which connects our network to the Internet.



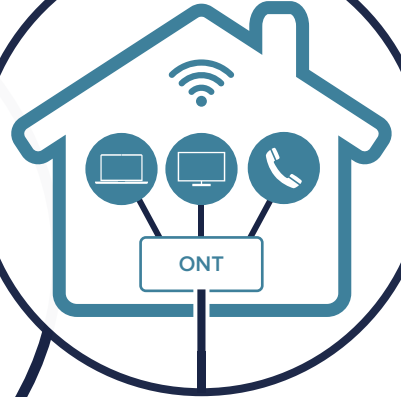

The fiber cable doesn't stop outside of your home. Rather, it connects directly to a Optical Network Terminal inside your home, which then sends service directly to your devices. Managed wireless service will be available as well.
